News from Germany



The Linde Group, one of the worldwide leading gases and engineering companies, together with Consolidated Contractors Company (CCC) won an order valued USD1.075 billion from Borouge, a joint venture of Abu Dhabi National Oil Company (ADNOC) with Borealis.

The order includes one of the largest turnkey ethylene crackers on ethane basis worldwide for the Ruwais production site, Abu Dhabi/ UAE.

The ethylene plant with a capacity of almost 1.5 million tons per year of ethane is the heart of a petrochemical complex in Ruwais.

BORSIG Process Heat Exchanger GmbH won the order from Linde for the delivery of the complete quench system for the ethane cracker.

Our scope of supply consists of 70 primary linear quench coolers, 7 secondary quench coolers, 7 steam drums, the engineering package for risers and downcomers and the engineering package for gas transfer line.

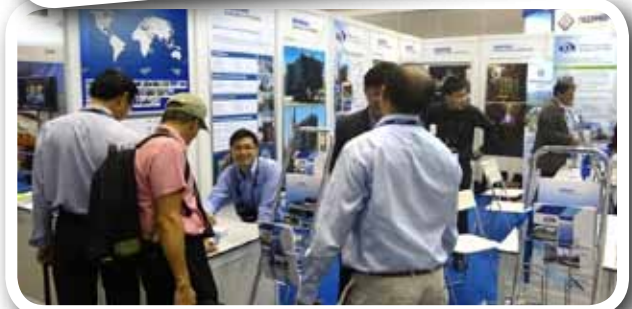
